

## Volunteer Q&A

Q: Will I still be able to volunteer for the Classic?

At this time, we do not know how many volunteers we will need at Pinehurst. We are still determining how many activities Pinehurst staff will do and how many we will do via our volunteers. It is very likely the Classic will need fewer volunteers in 2007 than we have had in the past. However, there will be many volunteer opportunities locally in 2007 that you can participate in as well.

Q: What other volunteer opportunities are there in the Triangle area?

Jimmy V week in 2006 was a big success. The V Foundation anticipates building on the bike race, tennis challenge, and Lazy Days events. With a larger V Week presence will come the need for more volunteers to help out right here. We will keep you informed via our web site at <http://www.golfclassic.org> and through the volunteer newsletters, which will continue.

Q: Will you draw volunteers from primarily the Pinehurst area?

We have tremendously loyal volunteers and we appreciate that so much. That loyalty is shared by the management team of the Classic. We will give top priority to current volunteers as we determine what our volunteer needs are, both in Pinehurst and in the Triangle. Depending on the job requirements and who oversees it, someone from Pinehurst may make more logistical sense. In general, however, we want those people who have done such a great job for the Classic year-in and year-out: our existing volunteers.

Q: Will all Triangle volunteers be housed in Pinehurst?

Some may indeed be, depending on the job assignment. We have not determined all the jobs we need yet, so it is too early to tell which jobs need accommodations at Pinehurst and which do not. We also do not know how many rooms will be available and where. Our goal is to donate the most money possible back to the V Foundation, so we must carefully balance expenses with convenience. We will publish our guidelines on overnight stays when we know more about how the events will take place.

Q: Will all the Classic events stay the same?

We are committed to maintaining the Reverse Raffle, Pre-V, Pairing Party, V Gala, and golf events. There may be changes to the format of the individual events, changes which are yet to be determined. The Reverse Raffle will stay in the Triangle. Saturday and Sunday golf will be on three of the eight Pinehurst Resort courses (2, 4, and 8). Due to parking conditions and the remote nature of some of the courses, Saturday and Sunday golf are not expected to be spectator events. In that case, there would be no tickets sold to the general public for the Classic. Jimmy V Week and the Reverse Raffle would be our public events.
